



Seeking 10 Non-verbal Communicators

Depth conversation
With the Silent Heart
of the Cosmos

In the uplands woods at the Stover's Séjour (5911 Western Trail, Greensboro, NC) a *Universe Walk* has been laid out along a ½-mile path. Markers at 100' intervals name the major occurrences of each billion-year period of the Universe's history. Brief readings from Thomas Berry's Universe Story highlight the eventfulness of each phase. On May 9th, a group will spend the entire day in a variety of non-verbal reflective exercises designed to appropriate the depth wisdom of the Universe. Each of the twenty one 15-minute meditative exercises will focus on the unique characteristics of each step of the Universe's emerging journey.

The one-day dialogue offers a unique opportunity for participants to relate the events and experiences of their own lives to the history-long creative abundance of the Universe. Participants will also have the opportunity to enjoy the spring beauty of a Piedmont forest.

Participants should bring something on which to sit (lawn chairs, meditation stools or blankets) during contemplative periods at each of the stations on the walk. Lunch, snacks and a journal guidebook will be provided.
